EVALUATIVE COMMENT:

George has done his practicum in two places, Grace Community Church in Tualatin, where he is involved in family, individual, small group counseling and client assessment, both behavioral and personality. His second counseling site is at Tigard High School. Here George is involved in the scheduling process and individual adolescent counseling, centered around seniors and graduation. He also has been assigned several students for on going weekly counseling. As you can see, Mr. Buettner has as much counseling variety as is possible.

Mr. Buettner has a long history of dealing with people prior to this counseling practicum and has developed a strong style that works well. He is both gentle and strong, he is quiet, reserved and thoughtful. Beneath this exterior is a very intelligent, inquisitive mind. George has strong counseling skills - he is able to confront a client when discrepancies appear or when a different way of viewing a situation needs a jolt to occur. He paraphrases and summarizes with such finesse as to put people at ease and highlight their thoughts accurately. George follows up sessions with homework if appropriate so that clients continue working between sessions. As far as record keeping George is well organized and precise in written details. He allows sufficient time for his counselee's and ample time between sessions to keep records and follow through with details.

I have found over the year that George spends a great deal of his own time researching and reading about counseling areas for more information. He is a very active learner who takes full advantage of every resource at his disposal. He has certainly taken on more in this class as far as time at practicum sites and in doing outside reading than was assigned. That says a lot for his dedication to excellence.

Mr. Buettner is a dignified, moral, intelligent and caring human being. If all practicum students were as well rounded and qualified as George Buettner the counseling profession and those of us who deal with students learning would be better for it. I recommend George with enthusiasm!
